

**Minutes of the Virtual/ Physical Meeting of the TSEWA National Executive
Committee held at 1000 Hrs. on 20 Dec 2025**

1. **The President** welcomed all to the meeting and thereafter requested the Gen Secretary to commence the proceedings.
2. **The General Secretary** gave an update on the points raised in the last meeting held on **15 Nov 2025**.
 - a) **Cdr Chandra Shekhar, Joint Secretary:** Cdr Chandrasekhar conveyed general perception on inordinate delay in progress and conclusion of AFT cases. Brig Vidyasagar highlighted the nuances involved and methodology adopted by Courts & MOD, Covid-2019, inherent delays and changes in procedures, etc . has cascaded into delays. Updates have been published on websites, email, and respective WhatsApp Groups. However, the recipients may have not perused emails or their email ID may be incorrect. All Zonal Presidents are requested to monitor each member/litigant for updates and dissemination as applicable. The President has concurred and assured of improving the dissemination & communication system.

- b) **Maj Gen S N Mukherjee, President East Zone:** Maj Gen S Mukherjee briefed on schedule and venues for awareness camp at Kolkata and requested for out-station attendees and brief on topics to be covered by Speakers. The president gave an in-Principle approval and assured that the details as desired would be forwarded.
- c) **Col Unnithan, President Chennai Metro:** Col Unnithan updated on resolution of cases with PCDA Chennai. Further, he proposed to hold an awareness Camp at Vellore on 14 Dec 2025. However, the awareness Camp had to be rescheduled to 11 Jan 2026. The financial outlay received was scrutinised and observations raised to Col Unnithan. Final decision will be taken on receiving clarification from Col Unnithan.
- d) **Mrs Madhumita Das, Vice President:** Mrs Madhumita Das conveyed setting up of a Multi-Speciality Hospital for Cancer Treatment at Lucknow with free facilities for Cancer Patients. The President requested for a Brief on the project from the Hospital authorities.
- e) **Brig C S Vidyasagar, Chief Mentor:** Brig Vidyasagar opined that the bulk of Charity activities should benefit ESM and their families. The President clarified that all grants received were for special purposes as mentioned by donors. Very few requests for assistance were received from ESM & their families. Children from EWS (civilians) were granted financial aid after verification and approval by Donors.
- f) **Philanthropic Efforts:** The President informed that Mr. Atul s/o Late Col Nagesh Chandra Gupta is willing to continue the Philanthropic activities of Madhuri Trust Foundation as hitherto fore.

Points by Members

- 3. **Col Vinay Sharma, Vice President North Zone:** Col Vinay Sharma raised an issue stating that the records of all pensioners (Officers) are held by PCDA Pune, hence they should also be apprised for amendments concurrently with MP5.

Brig C S Vidyasagar expressed his view that PCDA Pune has no role to play in amendments of personal Data and modalities of CGDA circulated has to be followed. Since documents like PAN, Aadhaar, etc have come subsequently and that to with varying formats, discrepancy in Data is inherent and it needs to be addressed separately with respective Record Offices.

However, for officers since PCDA (O) Pune is also in the loop for verification of documents, prior to action by PCDA (P) (Prayagraj). A copy of any documents

being forwarded to MP-5 for amendments may be also sent to PCDA (O) Pune.

4. **Col Ajit Singh Rana, President North Zone:** Col Ajit Singh Rana expressed his view that some incentive scheme should be adopted for Children of ESM with no prejudice to assist aid to EWS of Civilians. The President reiterated the reasoning expressed earlier and opined that in-principle the priority would be ESM & their families.
5. **Smt Neera Sirohi, Admin SSLOG:** Smt Neera Sirohi briefed on a case pertaining to a widow, Mrs Kalpana Singh who was made to pay entire amount of a Flat earlier advanced to Amrapali Constructions (at 30:70 ratio as in agreement with Amrapali) after the project was taken over by NBCC.

Smt Madhumita Das suggested that the Lady obliges to pay and after possession takes up issue separately.

Col Vinay Sharma also suggested that the Lady should exploit litigants Group in the same Amrapali Constructions for further action as there would be many Consumers aggrieved with default by Amrapali Group. Further, he reiterated that since bulk of discussions pertained to Single Ladies not in the Group it is now imperative that entire SSLOG takes primary membership of TSEWA without any inhibitions.

The President suggested that Lady proceeds with possession of the flat being allotted and thereafter take up a litigation with the builder.

6. **Maj Gen S N Mukherjee, President East Zone:** Maj Gen S N Mukherjee updated the Awareness Camp to be held in Kolkata & Durgapur on 01 and 02 Feb 2026 respectively, anticipated strength was 200 and 100, respectively, and a clearer picture would emerge closer to the date of the camp.

Gen S Mukherjee conveyed that the approximate expenditure for the two-day event would be around Rs 50,000.

There being no more points from the members, the meeting was declared closed. The next meeting will be held on **24 Jan 2026**.
