

**Minutes of the Virtual/ Physical Meeting of the TSEWA National Executive
Committee held at 1000 Hrs. on 21 Feb 2026**

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1. **The President** welcomed all to the meeting and thereafter requested the Gen Secretary to commence the proceedings.
2. **The General Secretary** gave an update on the points raised in the last meeting held on **24 Jan 2026**.
 - (a) After summarising the minutes of the last meeting held on 24 Jan 2026, the following updates were given:
 - (b) Membership drive during the Awareness Camp at Kolkata & Durgapur (76), efforts by **Col Srikantha Seshadhri (President, Karnataka)** at MEG Bangalore (96), and **Col C. M. Unnithan (President, Chennai Metro)** from Chennai Zone (100) resulted in an increase in strength to **22,797**.
 - (c) **Col C. M. Unnithan (President, Chennai Metro)** handed over a cheque of **Rs 5,000** received from **Col Bipin Shinde**.

POINTS BY MEMBERS

3. **Col Ajit Singh Rana (President, North Zone):** Col Ajit Singh Rana sought clarity on One Rank Higher pensions. Feedback was obtained from the lead advocate that **OA 664/2016 has 301 litigants, OA 1821/2025 has 69 litigants**, and the balance **33 cases are being followed up**, with assurance of filing within a week.
4. **Mrs Madhumita Das (Vice President):** Mrs Madhumita Das brought up a case wherein an officer receiving service pension was untraceable. The President requested that the available details be forwarded to **Mrs Shalini** to liaise with ORO during her next visit.
5. **Cmde K. S. Sandhu (President, West Zone):** Cmde Sandhu sought clarity on timelines for materialisation of unlisted NA medicines. **Col Srikantha Seshadri** clarified that SEMO should be able to manage within two weeks. RC should also be informed for a better response.
6. **Col C. M. Unnithan (President, Chennai Metro):** Col Unnithan conveyed progress in SFP of a widow, **Mrs Girija Naidu**. He also sought updates on ongoing cases and mentioned aid for financial distress for **Hav Mangal Kumar**. An Awareness Camp at Vellore would be planned in the third or fourth week of Apr 2026.

The General Secretary suggested that all members forward their speaking points well in advance so that appropriate clarity is rendered, especially for those requiring consultation with our legal advocates. He further confirmed that all updates will henceforth be available in a consolidated format on **WhatsApp**, in addition to emails and the TSEWA website.

The President directed that the case of **Hav Mangal Kumar** be forwarded for perusal.

7. **Feedback: Awareness Camp Kolkata & Durgapur** - Expenditure incurred was **Rs 1,50,000**, which included advance payment of **Rs. 1,15,000** and in-situ donations of **Rs 35,000**. Salient aspects are as follows:
 - (a) Fresh members – **76**
 - (b) Membership amount collected – **Rs 2,730**
 - (c) Donations by new members – **Rs 3,780**
 - (d) Donations by old members – **Rs 4,800**
8. **Updates by Legal Advocate Brig A K Srivastava.** The following are the updates:

- (a) The consolidated case of **Broad banding arrears beyond the stipulation of 3 years** at the **Supreme Court** was won, which included **two cases of TSEWA comprising 199 litigants**.
- (b) **OA 34/2016**: 135 cases require intimation of **Change in Heir with a fresh Option Certificate by heirs**, the format being sent. 22 cases whose whereabouts were unknown also have to be dealt with within timelines; else they may be deleted and the balance case progressed.
9. The President gave an update on the successful **registration for DARPAN on the portal**. The President conveyed his felicitations to **Brig C. S. Vidyasagar** for the hard work put in to obtain success in the **Supreme Court** in two cases, as intimated by the lead advocate.

The President also conveyed that the success of the **Awareness Camp at Kolkata & Durgapur** was well appreciated by all attendees.

There being no more points from members, the meeting was declared closed.

The next meeting would be held on **14 Mar 2026**.
