1. The **President** welcomed all to the meeting. The President thereafter commenced with the proceedings as enumerated below: -

**a) TSEWA Trust:** The President appraised all about the TRUST, which was formed by TSEWA and duly registered on 26th June 2019, primarily with the aim of safeguarding the assets and corpus of TSEWA, thereby enabling their availability and utilisation for continuing the activities of TSEWA. However, ever since its inception, the members of the TRUST had never met, and one of the Trustees, Gp Capt C. R. R. Sastry, has also expired. Presently, there are only 3 Trustee members.

The President thereafter asked for the opinion of the NEC Members regards the following: -

- i) Total no. of Trustees required.
  - ii) What all assets need to be transferred to the Corpus of the Trust.
- b) The NEC Members after due deliberation, arrived at the following suggestions:**
  - i) The strength of the NEC members to begin with should comprise of the following: Army-4, Navy-2, Air Force-2, and one Family Pensioner. Thus, denoting a total of 9 TRUSTEES.
  - ii) The matter should also be discussed with the CA of TSEWA and advice on the details of assets that can be transferred to the TSEWA corpus be obtained.
2. The President accepted the suggestion given by the NEC Committee and confirmed that necessary action will be taken accordingly.
3. The President thereafter gave a gist of the progress on the points raised in the last NEC held on 18 April 2026. Details under: -
  - a) **Mahima Sagar Fund:** Bills being produced by Ms Mahima Sagar are being duly cleared. The last bill amounting to Rs.17932/- has been paid on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026
  - b) **Legal Update:** No change in status from last report, though a large number of cases are in the final stage of hearing.
  - c) **TSEWA Membership:** The President and all NEC members appreciated the efforts put in by Col Srikantha Seshadhri in enrolling new members into TSEWA on a regular basis. Recently, he was successful in enrolling 17 more new members, thereby increasing the membership of TSEWA to 23024 as on 25 May 2026.

#### 4. **Points from Members:**

a) **Hav Harish Asthana (President, Uttar Pradesh):** Informed about 3 pending cases for further action since there has been no response from PCDA (Prayagraj)/ SPARSH, in spite of repeated mails / letters.

The President asked Hav Harish Asthana to forward the Cases to HQ TSEWA. These will be scrutinised and further appropriate action will be taken.

b) **Cmde K. S. Sandhu (President, West Zone):** Informed that there was a case of a sailor, Loomba, in Jaipur who passed away while in prison. The family pension has commenced, but arrears of the pension is yet to be given by PCDA. Action is at hand.

5. The President gave the following points:

- a) **Metamorphes Foundation:** The Co-Founder & CEO, Metamorphes Foundation, Col Pankaj Goel, visited HQ TSEWA on 13 May 2026 and appraised the President and Brig C. S. Vidyasagar about their organisation formed by a group of officers to cater to the welfare of needy ESM and Veer Naris. He informed that an event "**Battlefield & Beyond**" is being organised at Chennai on 14 June 2026 by Metamorphes, and extended an invitation to TSEWA to attend the event.

The President informed Col Pankaj Goel that Col C M Unnithan President Chennai Metro (TSEWA) will be attending the event.

Col C M Unnithan was also briefed about the event, and requested to attend the event on behalf of TSEWA

- b) **TSEWA 11<sup>th</sup> AGM:** The President informed that all necessary arrangements, including accommodation requested by members attending the 11th AGM, is confirmed.

There being no more points, the meeting was declared closed. The next NEC meeting will be held on 20 June 2026.
